CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PLAYERS

The Player Code of Conduct protects the team's reputation in the community and players should consider it their responsibility to abide by the Code of Conduct and report any behavior that does not adhere.

Any WDAFA player not abiding by the Code of Conduct will be asked to change or stop their behavior. If the player fails to comply, they will be asked to leave and disciplinary procedures will follow. The Player Code of Conduct includes:

Please ...

1. Ensure you are properly dressed for the weather. Mitts, toques, and jackets for cold weather and sun screen and mosquito spray for warm weather, and lots of water.
2. Washrooms must be kept tidy. Please use the garbage cans provided for your litter.
3. No food or drinks are allowed on the playing field other than water.
4. All equipment must be worn on the field at all times (games and practices). Players without their helmet on or mouth guard in will not play on the field
5. Be on time. One (1) hour prior to the games and at least 30 minutes before practice begins. Please phone to indicate when you can not make the practice or game.
6. Coaches, Trainers, Team Managers, and Officials are all volunteers. Please respect them by giving them your undivided attention and respect the decisions they make.
7. Give your best effort. It is just as important as a victory is.
8. One person is not solely responsible for a defeat. Remember you are part of a team. The whole team plays together as a unit and plays as a team.
9. Treat all facilities, and the opposition coaches, players, and parents with respect at all times. Remember you are a representative of WDAFA and the City of Wetaskiwin.
10. Understand that criticizing, name calling, the use of abusive language or gestures, negative gossip or publicly complaining towards coaches, officials, parents, team mates, and/or participating players will not be permitted or tolerated.
11. Foul Play or deliberate physical or violent contact towards any player (outside the play of football) will not be tolerated.
12. Never ridicule or yell at your teammates for making a mistake. Maintain a positive behavior and good sportsmanship at all times
13. Understand that conduct that brings discredit or discord to WDAFA will result in disciplinary action. WDAFA reserves the right to terminate any participation with/without cause in the best interest of the team.

Appropriate behavior allows everyone the right to learn, to be safe, and to be treated with respect, courtesy and consideration. Consequently, appropriate behavior with WDAFA is mandatory. Each person must take responsibility for his/her behavior and make appropriate choices.
